



Daily Routine

Opening: Prayers, Welcome Song & Activities

Circle Time: 1. Helpers (Flag, calendar, weather, water plants, line leader, snack helper)

2. Review (colors, shapes, seasons)

3. Letter Introduction (letter song, letter & song recognition, letter bag

4. Unit Introduction & discussion

5. Songs & Finger Plays

6. Read a book that pertains to the unit

*Time spent in circle varies from beginning of the year to end (20 to 40 minutes).

Recess: Outside playground (weather permitting) inside playroom or gym.

Center Time: All children will play at every center. All children will participate at the art & writing tables. Creativity and imagination are encouraged at all centers.

Bible Circle: Bible verse, story and prayer time.

Snack Time/Review: One child will provide a snack to share with classmates each day. Every child will have several opportunities to share a snack throughout the year. We review our days letter, number, etc...

Dismissal: Closing & Goodbye Song

*A new unit is done each week as well as a letter, number & color. Show & Tell is done once a week unless signified otherwise.
